Areas of interest include basic and translational research in virology and viral immunology with particular emphasis on human retroviruses, influenza, RNA viruses, virus-host interactions, innate immunity, and sensing of intracellular pathogens. However, excellent investigators in other areas are strongly encouraged to apply. Tenure-track positions at all ranks are available, based on experience. It is preferred but not required that physician-scientists are board certified in Infectious Diseases and Internal Medicine, with experience in patient care and teaching in addition to research. Competitive salary and start-up packages will be offered.
