Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where can I find my baby's picture?

Using your internet browser, go to the web site www.PennStateiNursery.com The site is best viewed using Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher.

2. How do I locate my baby's picture at www.PennStateiNursery.com?

When the page loads you go to the navigation on the left hand side of the page. Navigate to the quarter in which your baby was born, and then click on the appropriate month for your child's birth. This will then load a calendar page that has all the babies' first names that were born in the month you selected. Find your child's birth day and first name and click on the link. This will activate a javascript pop up window with your child's picture and birth information. Please note, we do not place the father's name on the web site (only the Mothers) to ensure that the highest level of security is maintained and at the same time making the web site convenient for your friends and family to view.

3. How long does my baby's picture stay on the Penn State iNursery web site?

Pictures will remain on the Penn State iNursery web site for a minimum of a year. Once they are removed from the web site, the iNursery staff will be unable to retrieve the photo or information.
