

## **SELF-ASSESSMENT OF CLINICAL EXPERIENCE & SKILLS**

1. The following is a list of common problems and clinical skills that are essential to Family Medicine. Your preceptors will make an attempt to include them in this rotation when possible. Your reading should include these common problems.
2. Pre-Clerkship Assessment and Post-Clerkship Assessment:

Before the start of the clerkship, please complete the self-assessment forms by **filling in the circles** on the left side of the forms, reflecting on your level of experience and confidence in each of the areas. Use the rating scale below.

At the completion of the clerkship, complete the same form by **filling in the circles** on the right side of the forms, reflecting on your progress in each of the areas. Use the rating scale below.

Your response to the **pre-clerkship assessment** will help your preceptor(s) to direct your educational experiences appropriate for your level. Please share it with your preceptor(s).

Your response to the **post-clerkship assessment** will help us determine the extent to which we are achieving our objectives. The material on these forms is **not** used for grading purposes. All information is kept confidential and is used for program development only.

### **RATING SCALE**

**Experience** - rate your experience on each item:

- 1 = I have **not seen** this problem or had this experience.
- 2 = I have **infrequently** diagnosed/treated this problem or performed this task (1-3 times only).
- 3 = I have **frequently** diagnosed/treated this problem or performed this task (more than 3 times).

**Confidence** - indicate how confident or comfortable you feel in diagnosing and/or treating this problem or completing this clinical skill:

- 1 = I **do not feel comfortable** with this problem/skill and would need thorough and regular consultation at this point in my training.
- 2 = I **can make some** decisions and do some preliminary work with this problem/skill but would need some supervision/advice in completing the work.
- 3 = I **can often** diagnose and/or treat this problem or perform this clinical skill, with direct supervision confirming my decision making.
